The Easton results of the Machine Vote on May 3, 2005 on the Town and Region 9 Budget for 2005-2006 are summarized below. I have also included the Redding vote that was reported to me by the Redding Town Clerk. The combined vote defeated the proposed Region School District #9 budget.

The questions that appeared on the voting machines in Easton were as:

1. "SHALL THE TOWN OF EASTON APPROPRIATE THE SUM OF THIRTY THREE MILLION, FOUR HUNDRED AND EIGHT THOUSAND, THREE HUNDRED AND NINETY EIGHT DOLLARS (\$33,408,398) FOR THE ANNUAL TOWN BUDGET, FOR THE FISCAL YEAR JULY 1, 2005 TO JUNE 30, 2006? THIS SUM INCLUDES EASTON'S SHARE OF THE REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER 9 BUDGET."

2. "SHALL THE REGIONAL SCHOOL DISTRICT NUMBER 9, COMPOSED OF THE TOWNS OF EASTON AND REDDING APPROPRIATE AND AUTHORIZE THE EXPENDITURE OF SIXTEEN MILLION, FIVE HUNDRED NINETEEN THOUSAND, SIX HUNDRED SEVENTY EIGHT DOLLARS (\$16,519,678) AS THE OPERATING BUDGET OF THE DISTRICT FOR THE PERIOD OF JULY 1, 2005 TO JUNE 30, 2006? (EASTON'S SHARE IS \$7,227,359 AND REDDING'S SHARE IS \$9,292,319)."
