Jeff Parker - Chair of Board of Education and Bernard Josefsberg, Superintendent reviewed the 2014-2015 Board of Education budget.

The Board of Finance has no control over the Board of Education budget, however, they were clear to express that the Board was in favor of the enhancements to the programs that the Board of Education wanted to provide.

They voiced their concerns that the enrollment decreased 17% from 2010 to 2014 and the adults increased from 153 to 155.

The Board could not justify supporting a contingency for another kindergarten and stated that if the enrollment requires another classroom the Board of Education should come back to ask for additional funds at another town meeting.

The Board reduced the education budget by \$75,000 this represents \$60,000 for this contingency class and \$15,000 from a variety of other lines. Jeff Parker will get back to the Board of Finance on what another \$25,000 would affect.
