The Board discussed possible budget revisions with Easton Board of Education representatives Jeff Parker, Scott Reiss and Tom McMorran with results as follows:

Jeff Parker presented a revised budget. From the original budget request of \$17,391,586 a reduction of \$241,166 was proposed. Some of the 22 items in the list of what to be cut included, the media specialist position at Keller, extra-curricular activities at Keller,

reduction in substitute teacher costs and reduction in utility costs.

In addition the BOE proposed that the town set up a non-lapsing set aside account and that it be funded with \$333,680 of the \$400 to 600k excess costs expected to be accumulated this year. The fund would be for education-related costs and could be drawn from by the BOE with BOF approval. The resulting budget would including spending all

of this fund.

A wide-ranging discussion of the education budget followed. This was followed by

several motions.
