

PUBLIC HEARING MINUTES

June 27, 2019

Public Hearing

1. Adam Dunsby opened the public hearing at 6:45 PM. The purpose of the public hearing is to discuss the application submitted by the Easton Historical Society for the 2019 Connecticut Neighborhood Assistance Act (NAA) Program for Historic Preservation. The program is designed to provide funding for tax exempt organizations by providing a corporation business tax credit for businesses that make cash contributions to organizations applying to the program. The Easton Historical Society had made such application of which one requirement is submittal to the municipality for approval. The municipality (Easton) then holds a public hearing on the program applications. Copies of the public hearing notice and minutes of the meeting approving the program must then be submitted to the Department of Revenue Services with the proposal.
2. June Logie thanked the Board of Selectmen for supporting the application. She detailed a bit of what the Historical Society would like to do; replacing the roof on the Bradley Hubble House and upgrading the heating/cooling systems, some of which has already been done. The proposal requests \$33,925.00. Adam Dunsby pointed out that the municipality must name a municipal liaison overseeing the implementation of the program. Easton's appointee is Christine Calvert, Finance Director. Adam also pointed out that a requirement of the program is for a post-project review to be contracted for and paid for by the applicant for funding requests over \$25,000.00. Since the Historical Society is requesting an amount over that, June Logie, although not aware of that stipulation, agreed that the Historical Society will submit a post-project review by March 1, 2020 (three months post completion of project, December 1, 2019).
