David Bindelglass called the meeting to order at 7:30 p.m.

Present: David Bindelglass, Robert Lessler and Kristi Sogofsky

1. Kristi Sogofsky moved to approve the minutes for the Board of Selectmen Meeting, October 7, 2021. Robert Lessler seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
2. Three residents spoke about the speed limit, traffic and whether the town can install flashing speed limit signs on Sport Hill Road, promoting the ET-P stickers to identify town residents and the Westport Weston Health District.
3. Robert Lessler moved to approve the following tax refunds as recommended by Krista Kot, Tax Collector. 1. CORELOGIC-\$10,433.98. 2. PORSCHE LEASING LIMITED - \$464.57. Kristi Sogofsky seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
4. Kristi Sogofsky moved to approve the Road Opening Bond Release, PERMIT #1113, 37 Adirondack Trail, to Polster Industries LLC, Inc. in the amount of \$750.00 as recommended by Bruce Bombero, Deputy Director of Public Works. Robert Lessler seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
5. Robert Lessler made a motion to approve the updated Release for Personal Data Record Information. Kristi Sogofsky seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
6. Kristi Sogofsky moved to appoint Elizabeth Boyce to the cemetery committee for the unexpired term of 12/1/2020 – 11/30/2026. Robert Lessler seconded. Motion passed unanimously.  
Robert Lessler moved to appoint Kerry Caylor to Park and Recreation Commission for the unexpired term of 1/2/2020 – 1/2/2023. David Bindelglass seconded. David Bindelglass and Robert Lessler voted in favor. Kristi Sogofsky voted against. Motion carried.
7. Two residents thanked the BOS for their nominations.
8. Robert Lessler mentioned that this would be the last meeting of the 2019 Board of Selectmen. They have had a very successful two years and mostly unanimous decisions were made. Even when the board disagreed, they worked well together. David Bindelglass enjoyed working with the Board of Selectmen. He mentioned that the town was under the threshold and would be lifting the mask mandate on Friday, October 22, 2021.
9. Kristi Sogofsky moved to adjourn the meeting at 7:55 p.m. Robert Lessler seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
