Meeting was called to order at 7:06 PM by Chairman, Gary Haines.

1. Review and approve minutes from the Regular Meeting on December 11, 2013
There was no quorum at this meeting. They were approved as read. (Phil/Lisa)
2. Review 2013/2014 Financial Statement
The \$2250. expended, was for Jim Bria to repair stones. (See attached financial statements)
3. Budget 2014/2015
Gary met with Adam Dunsby, First Selectman. There seems to be no problem in receiving funds from the Town for next year. Phil noted that there was a phenomenal amount of work done at the cemeteries for very little funding. He said that the town should be made aware of this.
4. Update on Lyon Cemetery by Mark Lyon
Wayne said that he was working at the Lyon Cemetery Halloween Eve. We may be working at this Cemetery on the next workday.
5. Update on Center Cemetery (including Potter's Field Memorial)
A few stones were epoxied at the end of 2013. Polly's stone which was cracked and re-assembled.
We have the stone for the Potter's Field memorial plaque. The bronze plaque will be paid out of the Newman's own foundation. We will review the verses at the next meeting. There is a selection of three. Phil suggested there be a dedication ceremony which would also be an opportunity for publicity.

The spruce tree between Center Street & Aspetuck Cemeteries still needs to be cut down. Phil suggested this work be coordinated with representatives of Aspetuck Cemetery Association. Joan will research the new Aspetuck sexton's name. Gary reminded the Committee we are still expecting some reimbursement for tree removal costs from FEMA. Phil will follow-up with Ed Nagy.

6. Update on the Gilberttown headstone setting and repairs

These are now in the Aquarion storage cooler, waiting to be put in the cemetery.

One stone is cracked and the rest are repaired.

The \$5000. grant money was received.

8. Next workday discussion (April)

It was decided to wait until May to do work in either the Gilberttown or Lyon Cemetery. There is still too much snow. The next workday will by May 3rd.

9. Other business
