# MINUTES FOR THE TOWN OF EASTON CONSERVATION COMMISSION EASTON TOWN HALL CONFERENCE ROOM A February 25, 2020 7:30 p.m.

**PRESENT:** Dori Wollen, Chair, Cathy Alfandre, Vivian Hardison, Steve Hume, Elliot Leonard. **ABSENT:** Steve Corti, Sarah Cwikla, Steve Montgomery.

Chair Dori Wollen called the meeting called to order at 7:30 p.m.

- 1.) #20-564-Received January 14, 2020 + 65 Days= 03/19/2020-76 Delaware Road, Zolov, Andrew. Divert Stream by digging a swale and installing a berm. Andrew Zolov, owner, Ryan Bolmer and Ron Bolmer appeared on behalf of this application. Ron Bolmer presented a number of enlarged photos of various locations on the property including the bridge, the area near the driveway and the area near the northern edge of the property. He discussed installing two (2) 48"pipes under the bridge which would be 30 feet long, with a headwall built out of drystone. In addition, Mr. Bolmer stated the plan is to put large boulders and rip rap in the stream in the area near the house. Mr. Zolov and the Messrs. Bolmer were asked how this work would affect downstream properties. Ryan Bolmer stated he would still build a berm in the area of the property line, on the lawn. He stated he could install some check dams to slow the flow of the stream. Several commissioners voiced their approval of this suggestion. It was noted that this presentation had a number of different components which were not present when the application was originally received. The applicant was asked to resubmit plans showing the 3 main areas of concern: the berm area, the driveway area and the bridge with a detailed description of the planned remediation as well as a planned timetable to complete the proposal. Mr. Zolov agreed to this request.
- 2.) #20-565- Received February 11, 2020 + 65 days = 4/16/2020-Banks Road- Amerakon Partners, LLC (Robert Maquat). Construct a farm road with 2 permanent wetlands crossings. Rob Maquat, owner appeared on behalf of this application and the As of Right Determination request for the same property. Chair Dori Wollen stated that the original application had been discussed at the meeting of February 11, and that a special meeting was held to conduct a site walk on Sunday, February 23<sup>rd</sup>, 2020. The applicant had been requested to present the commission with some revisions to the application. She noted that the applicant Robert Maquat was present. Chair Wollen then advised that the Commission was in receipt of a "Petition for a public hearing" which had been received in the office on Monday, February 24, 2020. This petition contains 26 names and is under review by the Registrar of Voters to determine residency.

Chair Wollen also advised that the Commission had received a "Notice of Intervention" from Daniel Lent of 71 Banks Road on Monday, February 24, 2020.

Based on these documents Chair Wollen called for a Public Hearing on Tuesday March 24, 2020. She stated that the applicant must wait to discuss the revised plans until the Public Hearing.

The applicant questioned the intent of the Petition and of the Intervenor.

Chair Wollen read the Petition and the Notice of Intervention into the record. Daniel Lent, Intervenor, in reply to a question stated he would not withdraw the Petition or Notice of Intervention. Mr. Maquat asked if Mr. Lent was represented by counsel. Mr. Lent advised he was represented by Attorney Janet Brooks, who was present. She submitted a legal memo about "As of Right Determination" to the Commission. Mr. Maquat asked to be supplied with a copy of this memo by the Commission Chair. The secretary to the Commission was instructed to begin preparations for the Public Hearing to be held March 24, 2020.
