# Presentation from and discussion with Citrine Power re Virtual Net Metering:

Presenting for Citrine Power: Cela Sinay-Bernie; introduced herself/gave the TF some background on her work

Cela explained Virtual Net Metering to the group and why Easton:

- Interested in Easton because of the farmland (one of the 3 categories in the program: municipal, state and agricultural)
- Citrine Power currently has projects mostly in Eversource territory
- Investments are 20-25 years
- Market rate=\$2500/acre/year; seeking a 10-acre site to install a 2 MW system.
- Siting Council overrides local wetlands/conservation/p+z commissions; however
  Citrine always seeks support from the town first

Team discussed, asked questions, suggested possible next steps and contacts.

## HKMS efficiency update:
