- Brief discussion about the dedicated police charger; will need to reach out to Chief Doyle to settle the location before the TF can get an accurate quote to install.

# Recycling info/update:

Thanks to Joan, we now have a final, meticulously edited spreadsheet with information about recycling many different and hard to recycle items. Cathy will submit the list to the town clerk and update the Task Force page.

# Events recap: Coffee and Climate Conversation/Heat pump webinar:

Fairly well-attended event on the climate discussion coffee event (about 25 attendees or so); it was all q+a, with no formal presentation; many good questions

Heat pumps: not as well attended but had a very good and easy to understand presentation by Matt; about 7 people joined (in addition to Cathy, Lise and Matt, the presenter).

## **Eagle Scout project conversation:**

Cathy was contacted by one of the mothers of the boys who worked with us on the recycling cart stickers. Her younger son is now looking for a project. TF discussed a few ideas:

- clean up the streets for/on Earth Day, maybe also sorting the refuse between trash and recycling;
- signage for the solar array behind SSES
- labeling trees in open spaces by name (common/scientific)
- helping with food rescue at the schools
- pollinator pathway support
- build an observatory for night sky viewing

#### Other:

PACE reached out to Cathy to find out if we can help bring their solar ideas to our legislators. Brief discussion:

- Will look at the information booklets; inquire about priority items
- Discuss with our legislators and possibly invite both Hughes and Scott to our January meeting
