APPROVAL OF MINUTES:

Minutes of the September 17, 2018 regular meeting were reviewed.

Motion: move to approve the minutes of the September 17, 2018 Region 9 Board of Education Facilities & Fields Committee regular meeting (Hocker, Denny). Approved. Unanimous.

DISCUSSION AND POSSIBLE ACTION: CAMPUS IMPROVEMENTS

Mr. Perry gave a presentation on the current 35% status of the plans being developed by Gale for the Campus Improvement Plan. A brief summary of expectations for the 90% plan at our next meeting:

- · Barlow Drive curbing with asphalt curbing and unit pricing for concrete, granite and Cape Cod berm.
- Include Belgian block pavers set on asphalt or cement base, as apron at the beginning of Barlow Drive for a good transition.
- Mr. Perry recommends granite curbs around islands at the top of Barlow Drive and parking area at the end of Barlow Drive.
- Incorporate grass pavers for gator access pathway near tennis courts, to address drainage
- Include repaving of walking path from softball field home base to stadium.

- Increase size of turn on Barlow Drive to make it safer for buses to travel in both directions.
- Include alternate for concrete tension system for tennis courts but the base system will include fencing posts set in sono tube footings and a poured cement curbing over the top. Drainage sloping will remain but asphalt will be cut to control any surface cracking.

- Improvements to sidewalks, stairs and ramp at rear parking lot.
- Include some assessment of catch basins at the loading dock and on Barlow Drive.
- Timing of the track is very sensitive. It needs 21 days cure time after base layer is completed before first application of top coat. Topcoat application will take at least 3 weeks.
- Turney Road transition to Stadium Road needs to be inspected for appropriate location for a good cut.

Mr. Reiss will schedule our next meeting to include a site walk/inspection to ensure that we have covered all needed repairs/improvements.

- Late February receive RFP bids back and pick Lowest Qualified Bidder
- 3/11/19 Start Bonding / Financing inquiries for referendum early May
