# III: Updates & Reports:

- JSP attended BoS meeting to present paperwork for contract between State and Town of Easton confirming that Easton has met criteria for future DoAg grant applications.
  - Discussed viability grant for funds to sustain a marketing campaign (xmas tree capitol of CT). Ag. Com. will look at process and time involved to apply.
  - Ag. Com. will also investigate signage opportunities for Merritt Pkwy.
- Discussed creating a flyer for Town Hall to increase visibility of Ag. Com. and encourage people to access its services. JSP will bring template to next meeting. Ag. Com. will draft memo and 1<sup>st</sup> Selectman will circulate to staff.
- Ag. Com will investigate temporary signage for SSES Farm Plot. At past meetings, SG has committed to
  provide funds for sign.
- BoS has approved \$250 for application for BRBC. Ag. Com. and all farmers become members under one
  membership. Ag. Com. sees a win-win for all sides. For example, BRBC is interested in internships on
  farms while Trumbull's restaurant week will extend invitation to Easton farms.
  - o BRBC Open House in April –All farmers welcome.
- Set agenda item for April meeting: will work on a list of priorities and communicate benefits of membership to farmers.
