Commissioner Miranda called the meeting to order at 7:35 pm

Marshal Neary provided Marshal Report for February, 2015. The Commission discussed sprinkler System compliance at Samuel Staples School.

Chief Waugh provided February incident report and personnel response to incidents, . Chief Waugh stood with Fire Fighter Jon Davis and announced that Jon has met all requirements for his position. Commissioner Buchannan motioned to have Fire Fighter Davis taken off probation and recognized as a Full Fire Fighter. Commissioner Pajonas seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously. The Chief and the commission will coordinate an official recognition ceremony for Fire Fighter Davis. Chief went over calls for the month of February and stated a 911 call from a man having a heart attack at trout brook valley. Easton fire department responded along with fire departments from Weston, Redding, and Easton Pd. Fire fighter Davies extracted the man on foot then the Weston FD came in to help with an ATV. The Chief and commission discussed the possible need of an ATV vehicle such as the Polaris that Weston used.

Chief reported that there are currently 6 people enrolled in Fire 1 training and 2 people taking driving class for a Q endorsement.

Fire Fighter Wright and Chief Waugh discussed maintenance on dry hydrants with the commission.

Commission and Chief also commented on the letter of praise for the fire department from The principal of Samuel Staples School for their quick action in getting to the school and stopping a potential flood with a lot of damage from a frozen pipe.

Commission and Chief discussed BOF meeting.

Commissioner Buchanan motioned to adjourn the meeting at 8:46 pm. Commissioner Miranda seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.
