Board of Fire Commissioners Regular Meeting Minutes December 21<sup>st</sup>, 2022 Filed subject to approval

The meeting was called to order at 7:30pm. Commissioner Buchanan moved to approve the November 2022 minutes. Commissioner Katz seconded. Minutes approved unanimously with no changes.

Chief Klem gave his report.

- There were 53 incidents in November, projecting approximately 500 calls annually, which is normal.
- The Board of Finance approved expenditures of \$27,000 for new gear and \$56,000 for SCBA equipment.
- The current budget is on track with anticipated spending and expenses. Planning for 2023-2024 will begin in January 2023.
- Engine 1 is due to be replaced within a few years. Chief Klem recommends beginning the specification process in January 2023.
- The Department is back on Spotter Dog for EMS calls.
- 15 residents responded to the EVFD request for new members. There will be four new full members and five taking Fire One in January 2023.

The Fire Marshall gave his report (attached).

There was no new business to discuss.

Commissioner Katz moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:35 PM. Commissioner Miranda seconded it. The motion passed unanimously.
