The Easton Police Commission Meeting was called to order at 5:35 p.m. by Chairman Colangelo.

I. PRELIMINARY BUSINESS

- A. Chief Candee received a letter from former Commission Chairman Robert Nicola regarding a Traffic Authority Conference.

- A. Chief Candee distributed his monthly report. Of note were 9 delays in response time, spread across all three shifts.
B. Chief Candee gave an update on the Communications Console project.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Commissioner Gelfand moved to approve the minutes of the September 8, 2014, Regular Meeting, and the motion was seconded by Vice Chairman Martin. The motion passed unopposed.
B. A discussion was held regarding Adirondack Trail Subdivision. Chairman Colangelo moved to approve the two stop signs as indicated in the map showing driveways at the Adirondack Estates. Vice Chairman Martin seconded the motion, and the motion passed unopposed.

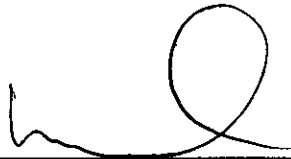
