 1. Review of Budget and comment as to allotment of capitol assets (i.e. cars, cameras, etc.).

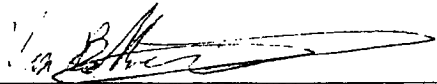
IV. NEW BUSINESS
