III. OLD BUSINESS

- A. Chief Candee distributed his monthly activity report
- B. Chief Candee reported on progress of installation of Communication Console

IV. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Chairman Colangelo moved to approve the minutes from October 13, 2014, regular meeting & the motion was seconded by Commissioner Israel. The motion passed unopposed.
- B. Adirondack Trail subdivision explanation given to Police Commission by Mr. Harold Rosnick restricted traffic configuration. The commission asked Chief to review the proposed plans and provide recommendations for the next Commission Meeting.

- C. The commission reviewed 2015 meetings schedule. Chairman Colangelo moved to approve. Commissioner Gelfand seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
- D. Chairman Colangelo made a motion to approve up to \$20,000 of asset forfeiture funding for electrical weapon replacement and update. Vice Chairman Martin seconded the motion. The motion passed unanimously.
- E. Initial discussion of Chief of Easton Police Selection Process was introduced. Chairman Colangelo made a motion to enter into agreement with CT Police Chiefs Association for resume screening for the Easton Police Commission. The motion was seconded by Vice Chairman Martin and was passed unopposed.
