III. CHIEF'S MONTHLY ACTIVITY REPORT

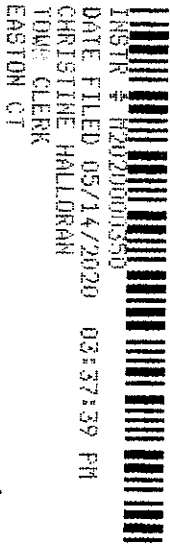
- A. The March and April Incident Analyses were reviewed noting one (1) delayed response on the third shift in March, and no delays in April.

V. NEW BUSINESS

- A. A motion was made by Commissioner Battaglia to approve the Minutes for the Special Meeting of March 5, 2020. Commissioner Smith seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
- B. A motion was made by Chairman Colangelo to approve a road use permit for the 2020 ALS TDI Tri-State Trek as requested by the ALS Therapy Development Institute. Commissioner Herrmann seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.

- E. A motion was made by Chairman Colangelo to increase the Special Duty Billing Rate for officers to \$80 per hour for fiscal year 2021. Commissioner Herrmann seconded the motion and the motion passed unanimously.
