I. PRELIMINARY BUSINESS

- A. Newtown Police Lieutenant Christopher Vanghele wrote to thank Mark Pastor for his participation in regional review training at Western Connecticut State University.

- A. Chief Candee distributed his monthly report. Of note were 11 delays in response time, spread across all three shifts.
B. Chief Candee reported to the Commission that this year's budget was a 2.18% increase over last year.
C. Chief Candee gave an update on the Communications Console project.

IV. NEW BUSINESS

- A. Vice Chairman Martin moved to approve the minutes of the March 10, 2014, Regular Meeting, and the motion was seconded by Commissioner Gelfand. The motion passed unopposed.
B. The Commission reviewed a proposed Department Awards and Citations Policy.

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- C. Vice Chairman Martin made a motion to amend the agenda to include additional new business and allow Chief Candee to present an application by the Tri State Trek Bike Tour. - D. Upon the recommendation of Officer Brennan, and based upon the submission of all required paperwork and permits, Chairman Colangelo moved to approve the application of the 2014 Tri State Trek Bike Tour. Vice Chairman Martin seconded the motion, which passed unanimously.
