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David Bindelglass called the meeting to order at 7:33 p.m.

Present: David Bindelglass, Kristi Sogofsky

Absent: Robert Lessler

1. Kristi Sogofsky moved to approve the minutes of the Board of Selectmen Meeting, December 15, 2022. David Bindelglass seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
2. A resident asked for an update on the Conservation Restriction and Aspetuck Land Trust Sale, tank removal at the South Park property and whether an extension was signed with the Aspetuck Land Trust. Dave responded that the Conservation Restriction and Aspetuck Land Trust Sale is with the engineer for a lot line revision. Ed Nagy, Department of Public Works, is working on removing the tank at South Park. The Aspetuck Land Trust sale deadline was extended and signed by all parties. This is not an extension of the grant from the state but an extension of the time to close. A resident shared his concerns regarding the town's permit process regarding the removal of commercial tanks at the Easton Village Store.
3. Kristi Sogofsky moved to approve the following tax refunds as recommended by Krista Kot, Tax Collector. 1. TOYOTA LEASE TRUST-\$116.85. 2. NISSAN INFINITI LT LLC-\$496.99. David Bindelglass seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
4. Kristi Sogofsky made a motion to approve the appointments and reappointments to the boards and commissions (see attached) with the exception of Conservation Commission. David Bindelglass seconded. Motion passed unanimously. David Bindelglass accepted Conservation Commission reappointments (see attached).
5. A resident asked when we can expect the Conservation Restriction to be filed with the land records. Dave responded "by the end of January." She also asked if there was an update with the lease for the Blaze's, to which Dave replied "there is not due to the holidays." The resident who shared his concerns regarding the tank removal at EVS read an email he sent to the Town and requested clarification from the First Selectman.
6. Board members wished everyone a Happy New Year.
7. David Bindelglass moved to adjourn the meeting at 8:07 p.m. Kristi Sogofsky seconded. Motion passed unanimously.
