#### Dear Board Members:

At its meeting of August 28, 2017 the Planning and Zoning Commission discussed your proposal, by letter dated August 22, 2017, for Phase II of the Solar Project, for a group of solar power panels to be located to the rear of Samuel Staples Elementary School. The Commission also reviewed a sketch map provided by Ed Nagy, Town Engineer.

The Commission found that the electric energy generated by the panels would be a substantial benefit to the Samuel Staples School, as well as potentially to other Town buildings, and that the location proposed is consistent with the Town Plan of Conservation and Development and is also generally consistent with the "Morehouse Civic Park" plan.

By unanimous vote, the Commission recommended that a favorable response to this 8-24 referral, for proposed installation of Phase II Solar Power Panels, be given to the Board of Selectmen, subject to receiving satisfactory feedback from Parks and Recreation regarding this referral; response to be received by the meeting of September 11, 2017.

At the meeting of September 11, 2017 the Commission received confirmation from Chairman Robert Maquat that the Director of Parks and Recreation, Gary Simone, had stated that the proposed location for the solar array was not in conflict with plans that Parks and Recreation had for that location (please see attached e-mail).

#### Park and Recreation Department Review Committee Charge

There shall be a Committee to review the operations and structure of the Park and Recreation Department. The Committee shall consist of five members including the First Selectman, two members of the Park and Recreation Commission, and two members of the public. The Selectmen, unless otherwise appointed with vote, shall be ex officio members without vote. The appointing authority shall be the Board of Selectmen.

The Committee shall be structured as a subcommittee of the Board of Selectmen.

The Committee shall be advisory and shall report its findings and recommendations to the Board of Selectmen and the Park and Recreation Commission.

The Committee shall report its findings and recommendations to the Board of Selectmen no later than January 4<sup>th</sup> 2018, and shall update the Board of Selectmen and Park and Recreation Commission as requested.

The Board of Selectmen shall disband the Committee when it deems its work substantially complete.

The Board of Selectmen may amend this charge as it deems necessary.
