Restoration Notes:

Tombstone was found near the outer edge of the cemetery closest to the water's edge. The stone had been knocked over and was facing in the wrong direction. Stone restoration involved lifting the stone via tripod, turning it around and using monument compound and epoxy to reset the tombstone.
