## MINUTES FOR THE TOWN OF EASTON CONSERVATION COMMISSION EASTON TOWN HALL CONFERENCE ROOM A March 10, 2020 7:30 p.m.

Chair Dori Wollen called the meeting called to order at 7:30 p.m.

Steve Montgomery was appointed to vote for Cathy Alfandre.

- 1.) #20-564-Received January 14, 2020 + 65 Days = 03/19/2020-76 Delaware Road, Zolov, Andrew. Divert Stream by digging a swale and installing a berm. Andrew Zolov, owner, Ryan Bolmer, contractor, and Ron Bolmer, engineer appeared on behalf of this application. Dori Wollen stated that at the last meeting a detailed description of the planned remediation had been requested, which was supplied to the Commission along with pictures of the sites. Chair Wollen said that the planned remediation of locations 2 and 3 were acceptable, however when Town Engineer Ed Nagy reviewed location 1, he wanted to see the volume of the water, measurements, and a certified engineers stamp on the plan of remediation. Commissioners reminded the applicant that they had asked for a professional engineers input during earlier meetings. The Commission has no authority over the Towns highway department. Mr. Zolov was advised that if he requested an extension for 35 days, he would be able to present a professional engineers plans at a subsequent meeting. Mr. Zolov requested in writing that this application be extended 35 days until April 23, 2020.

The Intervenor Daniel Lent was present. Chair Wollen read into the record an e-mail from the applicant requesting that the public hearing be postponed.

VOTE: The request to postpone the public hearing on application #20-565 and As of Right Determination #20-566 until April 14, 2020 was approved by unanimous voice vote.

Chair Wollen has been researching dog leash ordinances in nearby towns. She found that New Canaan, Fairfield, Weston and Trumbull all have regulations or ordinances. She has asked the members of the Commission to read them and see if there are any sections that should be considered for use in Easton.
