MINUTES FOR THE TOWN OF EASTON CONSERVATION COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING HELD VIA ZOOM AND IN PERSON CONFERENCE ROOM "A" TOWN HALL August 24, 2021 7:30 p.m.

Chair Dori Wollen called the meeting to order at 7:35. Karin Niesyn was appointed to vote for Steve Montgomery.

Robert Klem, President of the Volunteer Fire Company appeared via zoom. James Wright appeared on behalf of this application in person after technical difficulties prevented his participation via zoom, Several Commissioners had questions regarding the description of the project as the site plan was not accurate in labeling roads, placement of the firehouse and planned removal of trees. The Commission requested that the site plan be corrected to more accurately show the planned project before a site walk takes place. Chair Wollen asked that the proposed storage shed be flagged. Mr. Wright was asked to provide corrected site plans so as to schedule a site walk before the next regularly scheduled meeting on September 14.

Upon receipt of the Cease and Desist order, all work was stopped. The homeowner will submit an application and a remediation plan. Several commissioners commended the homeowner for their timely response.
