## MINUTES FOR THE TOWN OF EASTON CONSERVATION COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING November 9, 2021 7:30 p.m.

Chair Dori Wollen called the meeting called to order at 7:30 p.m.

Karin Niesyn was appointed to vote for Steve Montgomery and Maria Corti for Sarah Cwikla.

- 1.) #21-601- Received October 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021+ 65 days =12/30/2021-8 Canterbury Lane, Fuentes, Magda, Construct inground pool, remove weeds and dead trees. Magda Fuentes appeared on behalf of this application. Ms. Fuentes plans to contract a pool company to confirm the location and propose a design for the pool. Also, the trees to be removed have yet to be marked and therefore, due to timing issues Ms. Fuentes will request a 65day extension so all her plans can be finalized.
- 2.) #21-602-Received October 26th, 2021 + 65 Days = 12/30/2021. 433 Center Road, Alain Bourgeois. Construct 1 story house, detached garage, accessory structure, replacing current structures. Mark Ochman appeared on behalf of this application and presented a new map with a narrower, 13.5' driveway. MOTION: Vivian Hardison moved to approve #21-602 as shown on the map as revised 11/09/2021 with standard stipulations. Cathy Alfandre seconded. VOTE: Motion passed by unanimous voice vote.
- 3.) #21-600 -41 Adirondack Trail, Ong Lee- Received October 26<sup>th</sup>, 2021 + 65 days= 12/30/2021. Construct 2 story house, install house and construct driveway. The applicant was reminded that the driveway construction cannot be started until the silt fence is fully erected, i.e. around the entire construction site. MOTION: Cathy Alfandre moved to approve #21-600 with standard stipulations. Karin Niesyn seconded the motion. Motion passed unanimously.

  - C. V#11-158, Notice of Violation at 580 Sport Hill Road--Austin Ganim, issued 5/24/11. Received letter (Nov 9, 2021) from Atty Taylor, representing Mr. Ganim. Chair Wollen read the

letter into the record. Attorney Taylor and Mr. Ganim plan to attend the Commission's next meeting on December 14, 2021. This is in response to our letter of Oct. 21, 2021 regarding this long outstanding violation.

- D. V#21-585 Activities within 200 feet of a 3-acre pond- Lorraine McLaughlin, 105 Norton Road, issued 3/24/2021. Chair Wollen stated she has been in contact with Rich McLaughlin.
- E. **V#21-584** Notice of Violation at 1074 Black Rock Road- Trevor A. Smith, issued 3/9/2021, Cease and Desist order. Staff was directed to send a second violation letter.
- F. Warning re; activities within 100 feet of wetlands- David Harding 570 Morehouse Road, Easton CT, issued May 17, 2021
- G. V#21-592 Activities within 100 feet of wetlands-David Harding, 570 Morehouse Road, Easton CT, issued August 12, 2021. There has been no further contact from Mr. Harding. Chair Wollen will write a letter to Mr. Harding to be delivered by a Marshall.
- H. V#21-593 Activities within 100 feet of wetlands- John Stanczyk, 582 Morehouse Road, Easton CT, issued August 13, 2021. The homeowner's application #21-597 was approved but the remediation work has not been completed yet.
