### MINUTES FOR THE TOWN OF EASTON CONSERVATION COMMISSION REGULAR MEETING – EASTON TOWN HALL CONFERENCE ROOM A TUESDAY February 28, 2017 7:30 p.m.

1. Meeting called to order at 7:30 p.m.

#### 2. INLAND/WETLAND APPLICATIONS:

A. **I/W #16-518** 200 Morehouse Road – Susan and Anthony Farmer – new residence and pool 11/15/16 + **65 day extension = March 16, 2017** – Mr. and Mrs. Farmer were present at the meeting as well as their attorney Michael Bologna. The attorney had revised plans for the Commission and discussed the issues presented at the previous meeting. Steve Corti had comments regarding the overall application – he would like to see a report from a soil scientist, he is concerned with the surrounding properties and the water flow into 200 Morehouse Road. The Commission did receive the paperwork from the Board of Health regarding the approved septic system. J.D. Fazio, resident at 12 Morning Glory Lane was present and again spoke to the Commission regarding his concerns about developing the lot. He presented the Commission with a change.org petition of which majority of signatures are from individuals who do not live Easton. The commission still requires additional information. The Farmer's will have the plans revised and return to the Commission at the next meeting on March 14, 2017.

Corti stated that he recalled a previous As of Right Determination request from Mr. Sherwood to do this work years ago and it was denied. He would like to investigate if a map or any documentation is available as to the location of the wetlands on this property before voting on any decision.

Mr. Ochman stated that the current septic system has failed. The property has wetlands – a small pond approximately 115 feet away from the edge of the proposed new system. Location of the new system is constricted by two wells on the property. Mark Ochman indicated that the material being removed for the installation of the new septic will be taken off site. Elliot Leonard made a motion to approve the emergency septic installation, seconded by Steve Corti.
