2. INLAND/WETLAND APPLICATIONS:

I/W #17-528 – 14 Tatetuck Trail – New Single Family Residence and pool; The applicant's Engineer Mr. Bombero was present and stated this lot was created years ago via sub-division. The Commission requests he stake the property for the house, pool and septic and once staked Mr. Bombero will call the Conservation office so the members can take a look at the property.

Mark Ochman was also present along with Steve and Norman Haller who were the contractors that completed the work. They stated that no fill was brought to the site and no grading had been done. The area was smoothed over once the stumps were pulled out and the remaining dirt from the stumps was what was put back in the hole. The Commission agreed that they can plant a Conservation mix of grasses at the present time and will inspect the site as they see fit. If the watercourse does not return by November 1, 2017, Mr. Silverman might be required to remedy the situation and return the watercourse back to what it previously was.
