2. INLAND/WETLAND APPLICATIONS:

I/W #17-532 – Pond Cleaning at Aspectuck Country Club, Easton/Weston Border. Megan Raymond of Milone & McBroom was present to discuss the application. The pond is located on a golf course and they would like to do the work in the winter. The Commission will walk the site and discuss at the next meeting on January 9, 2018.
