- **CMED:** Call volume remains high in the area with an increase in mutual aid.
- **SW CT EMS Council:** There are two FEMA teams here in the state to do the transfers from the hospital to skilled nursing facilities. They are not doing emergency calls.
- **Cap & Operating Budget 2021-2022:** On target so far this fiscal year.
- **Personnel:** Josh and Pete delivered a baby last month. They were issued their stork pins. Another EMT was kind enough to help an elderly gentleman who needed his driveway cleared in order to receive his oil delivery.
- **EMS Building Update:** Still investigating the purchase of a parcel of land. The fundraiser that Renn and Janet Gordon so generously will match up to \$150,000 has exceeded its goal. The commission thanks the Gordons for their generosity.
- **New Ambulance Purchase:** Has been ordered and is expected to be here in November and in service by the end of the year. The delay is due to supply chain and computer chip issues.
