

Q1 How often do you travel along Sport Hill Road between Helen Keller Middle School and Silverman's Farm (Sport Hill Road Study Area)?





Q2 How do you travel in the Sport Hill Road Study Area? (select all that apply)







Q4 Do you think safety is an issue within the Sport Hill Road Study Area?










Q8 Would you consider biking along the Sport Hill Road Study Area if improvements were made?




