Joanne will find out how long the project will take and whether or not the rooms can be used while the work is going on.
 - c. Fine-Free Status: Lynn asked the Board to adopt a permanent fine-free status for the Library. Linda made a motion and Adrienne seconded. The motion passed unanimously.

9. New Business:

- a. Gardening Plans: Jean Stetz-Puchalski presented the Garden Club's ideas for supporting the Library's grounds with a fixed sensory garden on the left side of the Conference Room door and a moveable one for the back patio. She is hoping to have these completed this fall. Longer-range plans also include a native garden along the edge of the parking lot in back and plantings on the two islands in back.
