 - a. FOIA Webinar Recap: The webinar was discussed. There were items discussed specific to how Zoom meetings are to be conducted.
 - b. Collection Development Policy: The Dr. Seuss books that were identified by the creators of the books as being racist were discussed. The books in question were not removed but were deemed as storage status. This means that patrons that request the books will still have access to them they will just need to request them. A collection development policy will be investigated and discussed at a later board meeting.

EASTON PUBLIC LIBRARY BOARD OF TRUSTEES REGULAR MEETING – May 3, 2021 LIBRARY DIRECTOR'S REPORT

- 1. Dave Bindelglass has decided to keep the Youth Services Programming Assistant position on furlough until June 2022. It will be reassessed at that time.
- 2. We are in the process of setting up a Social Justice Task Force, with the goal of developing a Social Justice Mission for the Library.
- 3. Plans are in place for this year's Summer Reading Program. The theme will be "Read Around Easton." Every 100 books read will feature a new destination. Programs will be virtual or outdoors, including a Sidewalk Chalk Contest and Geocaching. Adults will be encouraged to read books that fulfill specific "challenges" and there will be a raffle each week.
- 4. Several staff members, including myself, will attend the Connecticut Library Association's Annual Conference (virtually) during the week of May 10.
- 5. At the polls on Tuesday, the Easton 175 Committee will have a table outside to promote Easton's many groups and organizations. I will be there for part of the day, promoting the Library.
- 6. I had a meeting with Dolly Curtis and Joanne Kant from the Arts Council. They were upset about the Conference Room sometimes being in use when people wanted to view the art. We came up with a viewing schedule (M-F 11-3; Sat. 10-3). Hopefully, this compromise will work for everyone.
