- 1. The outdoor tent has been purchased and is scheduled to arrive tomorrow, Friday, 11/5. It is10x20, burgundy, and we purchased the 5-yr. protection plan. The total price was \$534.98.
- 2. Our Decibel Double Booth is working out great and getting lots of use.
- 3. In light of the mask mandate being lifted in Town buildings, we are only requiring unvaccinated people to wear masks in the Library. The Community Room capacity has increased from 25 to 50 people. Also, we plan to slowly start to bring back in-person programs.
- 4. Our next One Book/One Town Community Read will be *Piglet* by Westport veterinarian Melissa Shapiro. It is the story of a deaf blind pink puppy that Melissa and her family adopted, which has inspired a school curriculum called Piglet Mindset. Books are now available for borrowing and for purchase.
