Fuel Assistance: I am still assisting with ABCD Fuel Applications. Call me to set up an appointment. Don't wait until your fuel tank is almost empty before you order fuel. The sediment at the bottom builds up which could lead to the need for repairs.

Medicare Annual Enrollment is going on until December 7th.

Senior Housing Assistance Fund (through SWCAA)provides interest free loans (up to 1,000) for individuals 60 years and older as well as disabled individuals with limited income in order to obtain or remain in safe housing. The Loans can be used for assistive devices, durable medical equipment, and home modifications if there are no other funding sources. I can help you with the application process. Payment normally occurs with in one week of the approved application. (Over)
