Medicare Open Enrollment begins on October 15th through December 7th

The process for reviewing or signing up for a Supplemental or Advantage Plan, or Part D prescription plan will be very different this year. There will not be the two days of individual appointments, but there will be support from myself and CHOICES counselors from SWCAA via telephone or ZOOM. Everyone must make an account on the Medicare.gov website before we can begin the task of helping you navigate the plan finder. I know this is not optimal for everyone, but no CHOICES counselors are allowed to assist clients in person due to COVID-19. Please call me with any questions you have and I will point you in the right direction. I will also post information on the town's website **eastonct.gov** so visit the site under *Municipal Agent for the Aging* or *Social Services*.
