FINGERPRINTING WILL BE DONE BY APPOINTMENT ONLY

To better serve the community's schedule, effective immediately the new fingerprinting hours are as follows:

Tuesday 3:30 PM – 9:30 PM

Thursday 8:30 AM – 3:30 PM

Call 203-268-4111 to schedule an appointment.

- Fingerprinting is only open to Easton residents, and non-residents applying for an employment background check for a business based in Easton or a vending permit from the Town of Easton.
- Valid government issued photo ID is required.
- If you were previously fingerprinted at the Easton Police Department and your fingerprints were rejected, bring in the rejective fingerprint notification letter as well as any other documentation that accompanied it.

Please be on time for your appointment and do not enter the building. When you arrive, please call the police department and you will receive instructions on where and when to enter the building. All fingerprinting applicants must wear a mask while inside the Easton Police Department. Make sure all your paperwork is filled out completely and accurately. The fingerprinting area will be cleaned and sanitized between each scheduled appointment.
