Call to Order – Mr. Lewis called the meeting to order at 6:30pm.

He explained that with Ms. Colangelo's departure from the Board the Committee has only three members so he ruled that two represent a quorum.

- Approval of October 20, 2015 Special Board Meeting Minutes Motion (D'Agostino, Lewis) to H. approve the minutes approved 2-0.

- Discussion and Possible Action (note the items were tackled in reverse order from the agenda in V. order to get the shorter items out-of-the way first.
  - 1. Motion (D'Agostino, Lewis) to recommend to the Region 9 Board the approval of the Administration's request that selected Humanities electives be open to both Juniors and Seniors approved 2-0. Courses Impacted are Modern Literature, Psych in Lit, Journaling, and the Fourth Estate. This reverses a change made to accommodate SBAC testing that is no longer needed as that test has been dropped.
  - 2. Motion (D'Agostino, Lewis) to recommend to the Region 9 Board the approval of the Administration's request that the name of Adaptive P.E. be changed to Unified Wellness approved 2-0. This change will better reflect the nature of the course and allow Regular Education students to get Wellness elective credit for their participation in the course
  - 3. The Administration's request to change the weighted grading regulations for Honors and AP courses to give a weight to all grades down to and including an F was discussed. This proposal will be discussed further at a later date as well as at the Policy Committee before going before the full Board for the usual multiple meetings required for a policy change.

Committee members had questions and explained their concerns with the proposal and a robust discussion is expected when this comes up again.
