

You are hereby directed to immediately cease work in wetlands and watercourses and appear at the next regularly-scheduled meeting of the Inland Wetlands Agency on January 12, 2021.



RE: Warning re: activities within 200 feet of Norton pond


Dear Mrs. McLaughlin,

It has come to our attention that you have disturbed and are excavating in the regulated area within 200 feet of Norton Pond. This work is being carried out close to inland wetlands and watercourses, regulated by the Easton Conservation Commission acting as the Inland Wetlands and Watercourses Agency under Section 22a-36 through 22a-45 of the Connecticut General Statutes. This law requires that a permit be obtained prior to conducting regulated activities affecting inland wetlands and watercourses. Although wetlands and watercourses may not have been altered at this time, the work constitutes a regulated activity as defined in the regulations. Additionally, it was noted that proper sediment and erosion controls were not in place. Runoff from the work area could adversely affect the wetlands or watercourses.

Please appear at the next regularly-scheduled meeting of the Inland Wetlands Agency, on January 12, 2020 to discuss the unauthorized activity. Any additional regulated activities will cause the Agency to initiate enforcement action, including but not limited to the issuance of a cease and desist order.
