

115 Mile Common Project Narrative

The goal of the project at 115 Mile Common is to remove the sediment which has built up as a result of inlet sediment deposits. In the area of approximately 2,700 square feet there is an average of 2 feet of sediment which has filled in. To remove the sediment a trailer mounted dredge pump will be used. The suction hose of the pump will be manipulated by hand to remove the sediment and regain the depth. The material will be pumped to a dewatering tube located on the shore of the pond. This tube, approximately 23'x50' will retain the sediment and allow the water to drain back to the pond. Once dredging is complete the tube will be left to dry for approximately 8 weeks until it can be cut open and the material removed and disposed off of site at our facility at 151 Danbury Road, New Milford, CT. The tube will be disposed of and its location allowed to regrow as a buffer.
