The Easton Cemetery Committee announces its 3<sup>rd</sup> historical tour in its 2020-2021 series which will explore Lyon Cemetery, a small family cemetery in upper Easton, and the vibrant history of the Rock House area, on Saturday, October 23rd at 11 am. The tour, which will be led by local historian and Easton resident Frank Pagliaro, will also include an overview of the region before the creation of Weston, industries that flourished along the Aspetuck River, the changing religious affiliations of residents over time, and the Black and Indigenous populations of northern Easton. The event will start promptly at 11:00 am and last about an hour. As the tour is limited to 25 people, registration is required. Masks and social distancing will be required per the town's guidelines on that day; participants should wear comfortable shoes and be prepared to walk on the uneven ground in the cemetery.
