

LEGAL NOTICE PERSONAL PROPERTY DECLARATION

The Assessor of the Town of Easton, CT, hereby gives notice to each person or business liable for taxation in the Town of Easton, including home-based operations, resident or non-resident, are required by law to file with the Assessor on or before **November 1, 2023** a list of all taxable personal property on premises as of October 1, 2023, on a completed, dated and signed personal property declaration form, pursuant C.G.S. § 12-42 & 12-43. Taxpayers are required to list all personal property (Except CT Registered Motor Vehicles) i.e. manufacturing machinery and equipment, furniture and fixtures, business equipment, supplies, farm machinery and tools, horses/ponies, mechanic tools, electronic data processing equipment (computers), cables and conduits, leased equipment, machinery and equipment (excavator, backhoe, etc.), unregistered motor vehicles, snowmobiles, trailers, campers including vehicles garaged in Easton registered in another state.

Failure to file or complete this form by **NOVEMBER 1, 2023**, will necessitate a 25% Penalty according to Connecticut State Statutes. The farming and manufacturing exemption applications are also due November 1st in order to receive your exemption. Failure to receive a form from the Assessor's Office does not excuse taxpayer from the obligation to declare personal property by November 1, 2023.
