- March rules for COVID will be adapted as time changes the circumstances that affect the nature of the pandemic. For the time being, as we increase the size of classes, we ask you to continue to wear masks until indicated as otherwise, especially if you are walking from room to room attending movies, exercise classes, and lectures. Small groups of friends who have been playing cards, painting, exercise classes, etc. may remove their mask if they wish during their activity. Please observe social distancing whenever possible. All visitors must be vaccinated or obtain a negative Covid test within 72 hours when visiting the center. All of the staff will continue to wear masks.
- We have been very fortunate as one of only 4 senior centers that have stayed open over the last 2 years without incident. We have maintained a sensible and careful approach to this situation. The most important issue HAS ALWAYS BEEN the safety of our seniors. This may mean life will be a little more frustrating for awhile. IF THE SITUATION ALLOWS FOR A REMOVAL OF MASK WEARING AT THIS TIME THE CHOICE WILL BE FOR VISITORS TO MAKE THEIR OWN DECISIONS... BUT CHANGE WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED UNTIL AFTER SAINT PATRICK'S DAY.
- A SPECIAL REMINDER TO THE EASTON SENIOR RESIDENTS: The Easton Senior Center BUS is available on weekdays and Saturday & Sunday's for grocery shopping, pharmacy runs, religious seminar visits, anything you may need! This is totally cost free. Please call for details to schedule, especially if you have an elder relative staying with you!. The boundaries for van service are Yale New Haven Hospital, West Haven Veteran's Hospital, Danbury Hospital, Norwalk Hospital, Bridgeport Hospital and all special stopping places in-between. Shopping can include help from the driver with personal driving, special pickups of medications, bank runs, and pharmacies. Special needs and homebound shopping can be completed by a driver. People using the van must have had a vaccination completed card.
- The Easton Senior Center has various activities available to any visitor especially to anyone who is physically challenged, lonely, depressed or needs companionship. There are lots of activities and classes available to suit all needs. See inside for more information, or call for more information.
