JOB DESCRIPTION TOWN OF EASTON

SENIOR CENTER VAN DRIVER

General Statement of Duties:

- 1. Skillful operation of a Town vehicle; transporting senior citizens throughout Easton and neighboring towns; taking seniors on excursions such as shopping, banking and doctor visits.
- 2. The position requires assisting seniors and occasionally physically/mentally challenged residents in/out of the van; and transportation of wheelchairs.
- 3. Van driver must secure passengers by utilizing proper safety proceedures such as safety belts, and proper loading/unloading of passengers using the wheelchair lift and stairs.
- 4. Escort elderly/partially disabled senior into medical offices and assisting seniors (physically/mentally challenged residents) into vehicle, doctor offices and into their homes. Pick up and deliver medical equipment to homebound Easton Seniors.
- 5. Maintain communication with family members on passenger(s) health conditions of immediate concerns, or otherwise, informs Director or Assistant Director of same.
- 6. Van driver is also responsible for compliance with safety regulations and proper maintenance appointments of the van including but not limited to; checking oil, fluid levels, maintaining full tank of gas, checking air tire pressure and keeping interior/exterior clean. Van driver also ensures billing is kept current from the Public Highway Department.
- 7. Chaperone group outings.

Supervision Received

Van drivers works under the direction of the Senior Center Director.

Supervision Exercised

- Responsible for the training and supervising of the substitute van driver.
- Enforces mandated van rules for safety and comfort of the passengers

Illustrative Duties

- Assumes all desk duties, follows safety procedures and coordinate daily activities at the Senior Center, including supervision of volunteers as needed, in the temporary absence of the Director & Assistant Director.
- Maintains and coordinates schedules in weekly appointment book.
- Maintain paperwork log on hours worked, services performed.
- Compile State Grant daily passenger totals and record new passengers.
- Flexibility if emergency situations arise.

Minimum Qualifications

- Maintain the appropriate Connecticut driver's license.
- High school graduate with a minimum of one year passenger van driving experience.
- Excellent written and verbal communication skills.
- Computer skills are a plus.
- Safe driving record.
- Drug testing required.
- Experience in assisting mentally and /or physically impaired adults.
- CPR and basic First Aid training.
- A basic understanding of the needs of the elderly in a patient and empathetic manner.
