MEDICARE OPEN ENROLLMENT

Open Enrollment for changing your Medicare health or prescription drug coverage is from **October 15th through December 7th, 2015.** Please start comparing your coverage with other options before October 15th. In most cases, this may be the one chance you have to make a change to your health and prescription drug coverage. It is always a good idea to review to make sure that your medication will be covered on your plan's formulary. If you are a "*snow bird*" then check to see if your plan contracts for out-of-state coverage – if not, then ask your doctor if it is possible to write for a 90-day prescription. (Ask if he/she will continue to accept your plan).

You can browse the website <u>www.medicare.gov</u> and compare plans and make a decision on what to do. The drug formulary of each plan varies, so that is why you need to check the cost from year to year. What worked for you last year might not be the best decision for the coming year – avoid unexpected surprises!

Fuel Assistance

Fuel Assistance applications can continue to be submitted and for those who have applied deliveries will start sometime after November 11th. Please call my office **203-268-1137** with any questions you may have or, to make an appointment.

Reminder Daylight Savings Time Ends November 1st

Turn your clocks back and remember that this is a good time to check your CO2 (Carbon Monoxide) detectors and change the batteries in your Smoke Alarms!
