2020 Camp Reservation Requests - Camp CONNRI

Dear Camp Enthusiasts:

We are excited to announce our camping schedule for the 2020 season!

Attached is a reservation request form to request the session you would like to reserve for your campers. Please submit your reservations to Elaine Belanger **as soon as possible** as slots will be filled on a <u>first come, first served basis</u>. When your reservation is received, camper application packets will again be distributed electronically as a fillable PDF. When disbursing the forms, be sure parents understand that <u>all forms must be returned to you for review</u> and that they know the date of their camp session. If you are sending a foster child to camp, you must request and include a release form from the supervisor of your camper's caseworker. Without this form we will not have permission to act in a medical emergency and the child will not have appropriate permission to attend an overnight camp.

<u>We must receive the application packet in its entirety</u>, complete with USDA form, medical form, and \$35 <u>non-refundable</u> registration fee by the Divisional Headquarters (DHQ) deadline listed above, which will allow us time to ensure all documents are complete. Note: *ALL applicants must complete the USDA form as directed in the instructions*. **Again**, please be sure to submit packets to Elaine Belanger by the DHQ DEADLINE noted above. All documentation (USDA and Medical forms and \$35 registration fee) must be received with the packet in order to confirm a camper slot. <u>All medical exams must have been completed no later than 12 months from the first day of the child's arrival on camp.</u>

A non-refundable registration fee of \$35 is required to reserve a space and may be paid by the parent or Service Unit. Every effort should be made to encourage payment of the fee by the parent/caregiver. If the family cannot pay the full amount, suggest that they pay some portion of the cost. The \$35 fee goes toward the overall fee charged to each unit to send campers to camp. *The actual cost to send a child to Camp CONNRI is* \$525.

TRANSPORTATION to Camp CONNRI is the responsibility of the **parent/caregiver or sending service unit** (who, upon authorization, will also cover the cost). NOTE: KEEP SAFE CERTIFICATION is required for any Service Unit personnel transporting campers in a personal vehicle. If this applies to you, contact me for details on upcoming workshops. Bus/Van travel arrangements are to include: securing all bus arrangements and obtaining, providing pick-up/drop-off schedules, securing chaperones to accompany children on bus (1 adult: 10 children), and providing a list of all campers riding the bus, on arrival and departure day and names of chaperones. Buses must remain at camp until all campers on the bus are processed through registration. The same is true for individuals registering campers so plan accordingly. In the case of RENTAL bus or vehicle transportation, advanced DHQ approval for rental is required. Contact Kathy for details.
